

Frequently asked questions

How to get there?

The Possible Village is located in Montreal's Mile Ex neighborhood. The welcome booth that will allow you to get more information on the event and its program is located at the Village Gate (see the map of interior spaces), at the entrance of Esplanade Montreal (at 6750 Avenue de L'Esplanade, Montreal, QC H2V 4M1).

Is there a registration fee for the event?

The Village possible is an open space for all, and the event is free. However, your voluntary contributions (suggested amount: \$ 10) will be greatly appreciated and will be used to finance the holding of the Village possible.

Where are the toilets?

The toilets are available in the building at 6750 Avenue de l'Esplanade.

Is the event accessible?

Yes, all possible Village facilities are wheelchair accessible.

Is there internet access in the Village possible?

Yes, you can connect to the internet in the Imaginarium (see the map of interior spaces). Ask for access codes to one of the event's volunteers, with red T-shirts.

Why can't I have a paper program?

The Village is built in a search for eco-responsibility. This program is only printed in very small quantities. We encourage participants to download it on their phones to reduce paper impressions. Some printed programs are available for those who need them at the Village Gate and in the hands of most volunteers in red t-shirts. Eco-friendly Village

Village Possible aspires to minimize waste production. For this reason, participants are encouraged to bring their reusable utensils, cups, and plates.

Accessible floor

Village Possible is proud to offer wheelchair accessible spaces throughout its territory.

Handmade Village

All possible Village signs and volunteer identification patches are made from recycled materials. Fabrics, cardboard, wall paint, frames and back of banners ...

Village respectful of all

In order to create an atmosphere of respect within the Village possible, the Transiro Collective encourages collective responsibility for creating a safer space. By participating in possible Village activities, the "guardians of the senses" and other participants of Transiro are encouraged to intervene in case of disrespectful or oppressive behavior, as well as to offer support. people who have difficulty expressing themselves or have not been included in the discussions.

Maison de la sollicitude - Safe space

The ethics of sollicitude, care in common English, connotes an important form of commitment. This practice, which is essential for the smooth running of an activity or the running of a shared experience, refers to taking care of others and of oneself. The House of Solicitude is a space to relax, to chat in a low voice and to take a break. If necessary, the Transiro team is here to help you, you can spot us by our red sweaters.

La Guinguette

Gratiferia

The Gratiferia, Spanish term referring to the Free Market, is a place where your items, clothes and goods are deposited and taken without monetary exchange. Everyone is invited to appropriate and to leave freely, according to the needs and desires of each. The Gratiferia is a practice of the handover offering a concrete alternative to capitalist functioning.

Exhibition space

Florencia Sosa Rey - One thing brings another

Florencia invites you to a participatory drawing workshop, carrying out together the documentation of objects given for Gratiferia, the collection of objects of the event. It will be a user-friendly action reflecting on the transition from one thing to another.

Morgane Duchêne Ramsay - Textile Expo

Morgane Duchêne Ramsay works as an artist and sewing trainer in organizations aiming for social reintegration by means of manual skills and creative expression. The artist will exhibit, within the framework of Transiro, a work resulting from these creative meetings.

Ophélie Queffurus - Mixed Media Expo

PhD Candidate in Visual Arts (UQAM / Université Rennes II) Ophélie Queffurus lives and works in Montreal. Since 2014 his practice has been around the cultivation of a unicellular organism called Physarum Polycephalum. The pieces exhibited testify to this process of taming the organism by the artist whose practice is available in multiple mediums and mediums (drawing, photography, painting, installation, etc.).

Morgane Duchêne Ramsey - textile-mile-ex

Morgane will establish an ephemeral camp to inhabit the space with gestures from domesticity. Together and through the textile work, the groups will recreate contexts specific to the history of women with the humble intention of arousing the community in passing

Maggy Flynn - Social Truck

The artist Maggy Flynn will be present with his social truck for Transiro! A place for all to meet and exchange ideas, children are invited to swing, to make drawings on the structure of the truck, to climb on the roof terrace, etc. Maggy will also make an artistic intervention, not to be missed!



Nicolas Chevalier - Intersectional Collaboration (FR)

To have a just and inclusive transition, all aspects of our world must be addressed. Whether economic, social or environmental, movements must be aware of other causes that are also affected by the same systemic roots affecting them. In this workshop, the participants will be presented with the 15 requests of the Leap Manifesto and will then have to establish the intersectional links making the requests dependent on each other. Then emerging ideologies will be applied to other causes brought by the participants.

Carminda Mac Lorin & Riccardo Petrella - Workshop "What humanity? " This participatory workshop is part of an international approach whose objective is to stimulate reflections and proposals concerning our vision of humanity. 



Hoodstock August 9th and 11th Cultural and Community House Of Montreal-North (12004 boulevards Rolland, Montréal-Nord)

On August 11, 2018, will be held in Montreal-North the 5th edition of Hoodstock. The program of this edition marks the 10th commemoration of the death of Fredy Villanueva. This tragedy that had marked the North Montreal community and all of Quebec was the spark that ignited the fire of the popular uprising in 2008 and gave birth to the Hoodstock collective. Recall that Hoodstock is a citizens' initiative created by and for the Montreal-North community that has transcended the indignation and anger to build, through the years, an active community involvement and who gathers each year at a neighborhood social forum. to discuss and think about socio-political issues.
